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TIME AND PLACE FOR FILING BIDS

Bids for the equipment as stated below must be filed in the office of the Public Works, Lower Level City Hall, 220 South Market Street, Oskaloosa, Iowa 52577, before **11 a.m. on August 29th, 2022**. All bids must be in a sealed envelope and marked "Oskaloosa Park Equipment Bid." Electronic bids will not be accepted. Bids received after the deadline for submission of bids as stated herein shall not be considered.

BID SPECIFICATIONS:

The bidder agrees to provide a bid on any or all equipment. The bidder will include all information requested on Attachment A - Bid Sheet. The equipment being sold is being split into eighteen items, and the bidder may submit a bid for one item or all items. The high bidder on each individual item will be accepted independently, and the bidder agrees to purchase one or all items for which they are the high bidder regardless of the outcome of their bid (if any) on any other item or items.

Item 1:

- 1999 Dodge Ram 1500 2-wheel drive. V6, automatic transmission with 112,000 miles. The vehicle runs rough and does have a check engine light on.

Item 2:

- 2006 Chevrolet 1500 Extended cab four-wheel drive. It has a 5.3 V8 with automatic transmission and 149,000 miles. It does have a check engine light on.

Item 3:

- 1990 Ford E350 with ambulance body. Two-wheel drive automatic transmission with Diesel engine. Has dual tire rear axle. Odometer reads 47500. Unsure if it is 47500 or 147500. Will need batteries has a blown out tire.

All vehicles or equipment is sold "AS IS" with no warranties from the city as to the condition, quality or safety of the same. Photos of some of these items are available in Attachment B - Pictures. Bidders must make their own inspection prior to the purchase of any items, and shall be required to execute waivers of any and all claims relating to the condition and safety of items purchased. Bidders must additionally agree to defend, indemnify and hold the city harmless from any and all claims for personal injuries from any person buying the equipment or any other purchaser or successor in interest from Bidder. Refer to Attachment C – Release Form.

All buyers shall maintain their own liability insurance for any injuries arising from, thru, or in connection with the removal of the items, and must execute waivers agreeing to defend, indemnify and hold the city harmless from any and all claims for personal injuries by any person arising therefrom.

PAYMENT:

The high bidder for each item will be expected to provide payment before collection of any equipment. They also will make payment by no later than September 9, 2022 or within 5 business days of notification from the city on award, whichever is later.

BIDDER RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Bids shall be submitted on the attached sheet, which will be completed in full (ATTACHMENT A – Bid sheet). Improperly submitted bids will not be accepted.
- Bidder shall have all equipment removed from the site by October 31, 2022.
- Bidder shall utilize its own labor, equipment and materials necessary to collect and transport all equipment.
- Bidder shall only remove vehicles or equipment between the hours of 7:00 am and 3:30 pm unless otherwise approved by city staff.
- The bidder is responsible for their own liability insurance for any necessary purposes for the removal, and will not hold the city liable for any injury or damage incurred during the removal of the equipment. See Attachment C for the written release which will need to be signed before removal of any equipment.



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CITY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- The city reserves the right to reject any and all bids at its discretion.
- The city shall make sure vehicles or equipment is accessible during working hours
